GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES

To teach, supervise and coordinate the camp's watercraft activities consistent with Girl Scouts of the USA, American Camp Association and New York State Department of Health standards.

PRINCIPLE DUTIES

- Give instruction to campers and staff in small craft skills and safety.
- Evaluate aquatic abilities of campers and staff in the lake.
- Participate in special waterfront events.
- Enforce water safety measures at the waterfront.
- Help to take care of waterfront equipment, facilities, and supplies; reports repairs needed to Aquatics Manager.
- Lead waterfront search procedures for weekly staff in-service training.
- Keep records and makes reports as required.
- Participates in general camp activities.
- Other duties as assigned

- 3. Current certification in American Red Cross Lifeguard Training and Waterfront Lifeguard.

- 6. Minimum 1 year experience with watercraft activities.
- 7. Prior experience in supervising staff.
